In Term Swimming Lessons: IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Dear Parents/ Guardians,

Interm Swimming Lessons at Craigie Leisure Centre will commence for all students from Pre Primary to Year 6 on Monday 22nd May and conclude on Thursday 1st June 2017 (Term 2 Week 5 & 6).

Swimming Lessons will run for 9 days. Due to the scheduled School Development Day, there will be NO swimming lessons on Friday 2nd June 2017.

The total cost (pool admission and bus fare) is **\$57.00 per child**. All students need to have paid by Monday 15th May 2017. Please pay correct money as NO CHANGE WILL BE GIVEN.

Students who have not paid **WILL NOT** be permitted to go to swimming lessons. Methods of payment enquiries can be directed to Mrs Teri Tan (to be contacted through the front office).

Students will need a bag clearly marked with student name, for carrying towel/racing style goggles. Long hair must be tied up and no jewellery is to be taken to the pool. Thongs may be worn to and from the pool but children **MUST** change into shoes on return to school. Students will change into their bathers at school. *It would be advisable that students bring a loose shirt (boys/girls) or a dress (girls) or a dressing gown (boys/girls) to wear over their bathers for transport to and from the pool.*
