PUBLIC SCHOOL REVIEW

Padbury PS underwent a Public School Review in December 2019. The reviews, which are intended to be conducted every three years, provide an opportunity for an external review team to validate the school's self-assessment of their performance.

Schools are required to self-assess themselves against six domains: Relationships/ Partnerships, Positive Learning Environment, Leadership, Quality Teaching, Use of Resources, Student Achievement/Progress.

The review team spoke to all teaching staff, the Manager Corporate Services, a number of Year 6 students and parents who represent the school council and P&C.

The feedback from the review team was highly positive and the school was rated as Effective. The school will receive a formal report in due course and this will be made available on the school website.

MINOR WORKS

The school currently has a range of minor works projects in the planning stages. These are:

- External Painting: to be carried out in Term 1, 2020 after fascia/eaves project is completed
- Internal fence - K/PP area: scheduled for term 1 2020
- Covered Walkway – Rm 18 to undercover area: currently in planning phase
