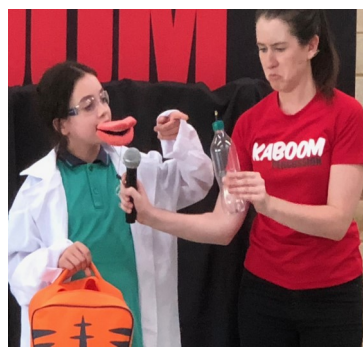
KABOOM PERCUSSION

LOST AND FOUND BOX

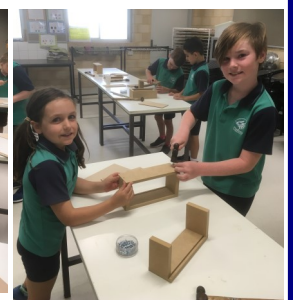
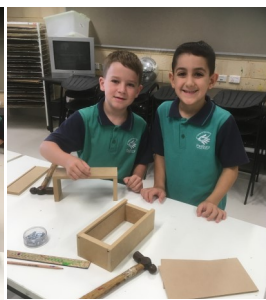
The wet area in B Block are looking after the lost and found box and will return named items to students.

SCHOOL PHOTO DAY—WEDNESDAY 11th MARCH

Our school photo day will be on Wednesday 11th March. We ask that all students ensure they are wearing the correct school uniform. (No Faction Colours please)

Every student will receive a personalised Kapture Photography order envelope to bring home today. Please see the payment methods below and note that the order envelopes go direct to the photographer on photo day. They do not go to the office or your teacher prior to Wednesday 11th March.

The recommended method of ordering your photos is online through Kapture's website as your payment is secure and can be easily verified at any time. If you pay online, there is no need to return the order envelope to school. Alternatively you can pay by cash and return the provided envelope to the school on the photography day. Please note the photographers cannot open sealed envelopes and cannot provide change.

Sibling orders can ONLY be placed online. Late requests cannot be granted.

You have the option to order a sibling photo package online, however please note **sibling orders will close in most instances at 12-midday sharp, one business day before the first photo date (therefore midday on TUESDAY 10th March 2020).** We suggest you place your online sibling order as soon as you receive your order envelope with your order instructions as places are limited.

Late payment envelopes cannot be accepted by the school office or by Kapture. You can place an order online for class or individual photographs at any time for the remainder of the current school year; however a \$20 fee will apply if you order more than 10 days after photography.

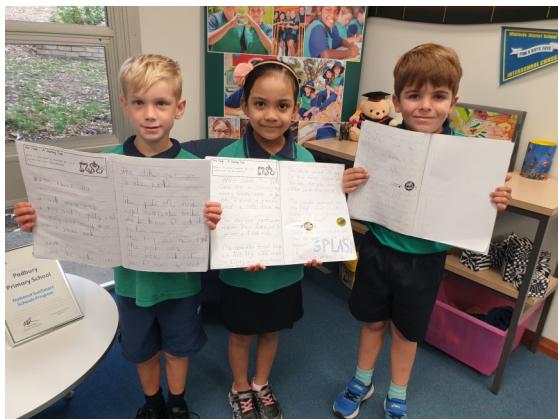
