Principal's Message

Welcome back to the new school year. I would like to extend a warm Padbury PS welcome to all our new families and trust you will soon feel a part of what truly is a great school community.

Staff spent the first two days of the school year engaged in operational planning to ensure we continue to build on the success of recent years. PARENT INFORMATION EVENING

TEACHER - PARENT COMMUNICATION

Class Dojo is an effective means of communication between home and school. It enables teachers to share student work and achievements as well as news relevant to individual classes. Teachers (and parents) are also able to communicate individually where necessary.

I would like to remind parents, however, that teachers may not always be able to respond immediately to messages so please be patient when communicating with your child's teacher.



Also try to refrain from messaging your child's teacher in the evenings and on weekends. Teachers, like everyone in our community, require some "down time" after their work day and I trust parents will support them by only messaging at appropriate times.

SCHOOL COUNCIL VACANCIES

Two parent vacancies have arisen on the School Council and I invite interested parents to consider nominating for these positions. Parent members of council bring their experience as parents at the school, and the views and context of the wider school community. The Council usually holds one (1) meeting per term in Week 7.

Under Section 128 of the School Education Act 1999 the function of the School Council is:

- a] To take part -
- i) in establishing, and reviewing from time to time, the school's objectives, priorities and general policy directions;
- ii) in the planning of financial arrangements necessary to fund these objectives, priorities and directions; and
- iii) in evaluating the school's performance in achieving them
- b] to promote the school in the community;
- c] to take part in formulating codes of conduct for students at the school;
- d) to determine, in consultation with students, their parents and staff of the school, a dress code for students when they attending or representing the school;
- e) to carry out the functions given by sections 70 (religious education), 99-4 (charges and contributions), 100-3 (extra cost items), 108-2 (personal use items) and 216-5 (advertising and sponsorship); and
- f) to undertake such other functions prescribed by the regulations for the purposes of this section.

Anyone interested in nominating for the vacant positions should complete the nomination form below and return it to the school by **3.00pm on Tuesday 14**th **February**. In the event of multiple nominations, a ballot will need to be conducted.
