Principal's Message

NAPLAN ONLINE

As I am sure most parents are aware, NAPLAN assessments for Year 3 and 5 will be conducted during term 1 for the first time. With the exception of Year 3 writing (which will be a paper assessment) Padbury PS students will be completing these assessments online.

In preparation for this, WA schools will also be completing an omnibus test to help the students adjust to the online platform and to test the school and state system to ensure consistent internet access. The omnibus test will have a sample of questions in literacy and numeracy to give the children an idea of what to expect when the NAPLAN tests take place next term. Thank you to Mrs Reid, Mr Gillett and Miss Atkins for their expertise in organising this preparation.

SCHOOL PHOTOS

It was great to see all of the kids proudly wearing their school uniform and their biggest smiles for the school photos yesterday. This was another event which is important to our community and ran so smoothly, thanks to a combination of experienced photographers and excited, yet well-mannered students.

BEFORE SCHOOL

A reminder to all parents and students that before the start of the day, children should gather in the old, undercover area central to the school where they can be supervised by myself or Miss Atkins in my absence. Parents are of course also welcome to keep an eye on their children in this area before making the students make their way to classrooms at 8.40am. Thank you to our senior students who continue to set a great example and encourage quiet conversation in groups or safely playing hopscotch. Parents too are most welcome to test their abilities with their children in this activity.

DRIVING/PARKING AROUND SCHOOL

- observe the 40km/hr speed limit when driving within our school zone;
- do not use the bus bay for drop off and pick up. This is clearly signposted and must be left clear during the hours posted;




