Principal's Message

OUT OF HOURS CHILD CARE

I am sure parents would be aware of the situation regarding the out of school hours care program. I appreciate that this has caused a level of concern and anxiety for many parents. I would like to assure parents that the school was not involved in any way in the decision to withdraw the program and were as surprised/shocked as parents when we learnt of the situation. We also offered suggestions to manage the transition but none of these were accepted by the outgoing provider.

Please be assured that the school highly values having an out of hours program to support and assist families. I can also reassure parents that we are currently investigating a range of potential providers to replace the outgoing service and are optimistic that we will be able to provide a new program in the near future.

This may take some time and parents may wish to look at nearby providers who can accommodate the children.

I would like to thank parents for their understanding and support during this time.

NEW PRINCIPAL

As previously advised, Ms Alessandra Morrone will be assuming the principal's role from Tuesday 6th June until the end of term.

A process to appoint a substantive principal is currently being conducted. Whilst I am unsure of the timeline, I expect the process to be completed in a timely manner and the school will advise parents of the outcome at the appropriate time.

HERDSMAN LAKE EXCURSION

Last week students from Pre-Primary to Year 6 went to Herdsman Lake to participate in a range of indigenous learning activities. Noongenboro (Herdsman Lake) was a traditional Nyungar camp ground.

Cultural history lessons from Nyungar Aboriginals provide a bridge of common understanding between contemporary and traditional thinking, breaking down cultural barriers as students learn about the modern and ancient ecological footprint.
