












Padbury Primary School will receive credits from Scholastic as a reward for our sales which is then used to purchase new resources and library books for our whole school to enjoy.

- starting Pre-primary, the first year of compulsory school and will be 5 years old by
 30 June 2024

Submit your application for enrolment to the front office along with a copy of your child's birth certificate, copy of immunisation records, proof of address (utilities bill) and any family court orders.
