## Principal's Message

Dear parents and caregivers,

#### 50th Anniversary

I would like to extend thanks to the Anniversary committee consisting of parents and staff for their time and commitment in planning and organising the event. Their dedication in organising such a memorable event undoubtedly contributed to its success.

#### National Assessment Program-Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN)

Over the next fortnight, our students in Year 3 & 5 will be participating in the National Assessment Program-Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN). This assessment program provides the school and parents with performance information in mathematics, writing, reading, spelling and grammar. Every child in Australia can sit this assessment to provide a valuable snapshot of a child's progress in literacy and numeracy. Parents will receive an individual performance report late in Term 2.

NAPLAN provides the school with information about each student and cohort forming an important aspect of our self assessment processes. The data will be analysed by our staff and shared with the Council. Additionally, the analysis will be shared in our schools' Annual report which can be accessed on our school website.



The Padbury Primary School P&C funds the subscription for every child to access the Reading Eggs program for students K-6. This is accessed at school and can also be accessed at home. The program commences with


- Reading Eggs: is targeted for K- Year 2. It assists with the learning of letter recognition and sounds, leading into blending to read words.
- Reading Eggspress: is targeted for Years 3-6. It provides learning focusing on reading and texts which engage students in robust vocabulary and stories with meaning.

We really appreciate this support as the Reading Eggs program helps children to develop comprehension skills by providing interactive and engaging activities that build vocabulary, reading fluency and the ability to infer meaning from text.

Students have been given a code to allow them to login at home. The students can complete self-directed learning tasks at home, supporting the home school partnership.

The program can be accessed on a computer/laptop through the internet or on a device.

The Padbury Dental Therapy Centre invites the families of children from pre-primary to year six who are not currently enrolled, to enrol their child using the <u>School Dental Service enrolment form</u>.

The School Dental Service provides general dental care **at no cost to families.** Your child's dental needs will be cared for by a friendly and experienced team of dental therapists and dentists. Enrolled children can attend the service throughout their school education, up to 17 years of age.

Your local dental therapy clinic is Padbury, located at Padbury Primary School. The service operates during school hours with some appointments available during school holidays.

## Our Services

Wonderland provides vibrant onsite care services from the outstanding facilities of Padbury Primary School's Undercover Area and Art Room. Our Operating times are:

Before School Care: 7am to start of class
After School Care: End of class to 6pm
School Holiday and Pupil Free: 7am to 6pm

We cater for all ages from our 3 year-olds ready to start their exciting first year of school through to our 13 year-olds transitioning to their High School journey.

Wonderland also offers a full day program from our Duncraig Service for our Kindy kids on the days they do not have school with a shuttle bus between Padbury and Duncraig.



### Our Fees

We believe all Child Care Services should practice complete openness and transparency with their fees. Wonderland's Fees for the commencement of 2024 are below. Fees are reviewed in line with changes to wages, insurance and other costs and any changes are communicated well in advance.

Before School Care: \$24 After School Care: \$36

School Holiday Care: \$80 + Excursion

Kindy Full Days: \$95

The full Child Care Subsidy of up to 90% applies to all of Wonderland's fees. Contact Centrelink to find out more about the Child Care Subsidy, or check your eligibility.

There are no hidden fees and charges imposed by Wonderland. We do not charge extra for Casual Bookings, Last Minute Bookings, Transport, Late Collection, Breakfast and the list goes on...
